FINANCE REPORT given by Beverly Atwood reported paying the Gallery \$1,200.00 for 24 uses of the gallery during 2016. Income for November was \$338.00; expenses were \$912.49 See attached report for details. The end of November balance is \$13,155.39.

Discussion prevailed around a video proposal (brought from *Creative Lexington*) in which interviews of artists of all persuasions could be shown on TV, Facebook, etc. This is referred to a committee of Jim, Henrietta, Dan Stahl and others interested. Artist of the Month for January (Betty Vinson) has declined and Jim will advertise for someone else and for others to complete the year.

An art entrepreneurship workshop hosted by the Guild has learned KY Innovation Network will provide \$500 for a presenter's fee on Saturday, March 4, 2017. It will be held at the Chamber of Commerce Conference room. Possible topics were presented. It was the consensus that it should be limited to 40 persons with Guild members paying \$15 and others paying \$20 for lunch and other expenses.

#### NEW BUSINESS:

Henrietta presented the idea offered by DeeAnna Sova of developing an Adult Art Coloring book as fund-raiser. Angela Comperry moved & Betty Liles 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Volunteers to develop it were Charlotte Hendricks, Angela Comperry, Betty Liles and Carolyn Self.

Carolyn Self moved that \$1,600 be rewarded the Gallery from a Wille donation to upgrade technical equipment. It was seconded by Beverly Atwood; motion passed.

Barbara Gardner donated her piano to the gallery. It is approximately a \$400 donation and it was the consensus that the Guild and Gallery would give her a lifetime honorary membership for her gift and her 50 years of Guild membership.
