It is hoped that Guild members could assist during this time as well with the extremely large volume of business we may experience during that time.

He plans to post all artwork in the gallery for sale on-line. It is hoped that artists' bio's can be posted as well. Thanks were given to Lynn Shepherd for creating an outdoor sign for the gallery for use during the Eclipse.

Gallery supplies: Lynn and Jack Shepherd should be notified if any supplies are needed. New jewelry boxes were purchased but need to be stamped with gallery information by volunteers.

Facilities: Angela Comperry asked for any maintenance needs to be referred to her. New faster WiFi has been installed and should help with utilizing the credit card machine more effectively.
