Call for Entries

You are invited to enter the 47th Annual Hopkinsville Art Guild Pennyroyal Juried Art Exhibition to be held at Hopkinsville Community College Auditorium Building Art Gallery, 720 North Drive, Hopkinsville, Kentucky. The exhibit will be on display from Oct. 2 through Oct. 29, 2017.

Categories

Artists may submit a total of two works in the exhibition in any of these 5 categories.

1. **Drawing:** (Pencil, Charcoal, Ink, Pastels)
2. **Painting:** (Oil, Acrylic, Watercolor, Encaustic)
3. **Mixed Media/Collage:** (Collage, Montage, Experimental)
4. **3-D/Fiber Arts:** (Cut paper, Pottery, Sculpture, Jewelry, Textiles, Baskets, Wood turning/carving, etc.)
5. **Photography**

Eligibility

Artists 18 years or older residing in Kentucky or surrounding states may enter. All work must be original and not from published resource materials or produced in a workshop or class with the help of an instructor, and not previously exhibited in the Pennyroyal Juried Art Exhibition. This is an open (non-juried) entry exposition.

Entry Fee And Procedures

An artist may enter up to 2 works for the following non-refundable fee of \$20 for each work entered. Checks should be made payable to **HAG**.

Delivery

Completed entry forms and fees must be delivered with the work either on Friday, Sept. 29 or Saturday, Sept. 30 between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. to a Hopkinsville Art Guild member at the Hopkinsville Community College Auditorium Bldg. Art Gallery, 720 North Drive, Hopkinsville, Kentucky. No early work or late work will be accepted as there will not be anyone from the Hopkinsville Art Guild there to accept them. Hopkinsville Community College employees are not associated with the art exhibition.

Framing and Limitations

All two-dimensional work must be strongly framed, securely wired, ready for hanging, and weigh no more than 40 pounds. Saw-tooth hangers will not be accepted. Sculpture and other three-dimensional art may not weigh more than 40 pounds. Freestanding sculptures requiring special mounting are not accepted. Top heavy or unstable work will be disqualified. Needle work must be original design and hand done.

Awards

This show will be juried for awards. Cash awards will be given for Best of Show, First, Second, and Third Place in each category. Honorable Mention ribbons may be given at the discretion of the juror. The amount of awards will be based on entry fee receipts and sponsorships.

Insurance

Signature on entry form constitutes agreement by the entrant that there shall be no liability on the part of the Hopkinsville Art Guild or any members or sponsors for loss, damage, or destruction of any works. Insurance of artwork is the sole responsibility of the participating entrant.

Sales

Sales must be arranged between the artist and the buyer. No commissions will be charged. All work must have a price listed for insurance calculations even if the work is not for sale.

Removal of Work

All accepted work must remain on display in the Gallery until the end of the exposition and must be picked up only on Sunday, October 29 from 3:00 to 4:30 or Monday, October 30 from 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m.. Work can be released only to the artist unless the artist has given written permission for a third party to pick up his/her work.

About the Juror:

Elsa Bekkala is of Sami-Finnish descent and was born on a farm in Keweenaw Bay Michigan.

Bekkala holds an MFA from the Rhode Island School of Design and a doctoral degree from Columbia University in studio/art education.

Bekkala has worked in; the West Indies, Upstate New York, Guadalupe Spain, the Great Basin Desert in Nevada, Providence Rhode Island, New York City and now resides in rural Kentucky. Her workshop, Studio 1898, is the former Bank of Lafayette building.

Her work has been shown in Europe and throughout the USA. She has had one-person exhibitions at Gallery 696 (Rochester, New York), Kirkhof Art Gallery (Allendale, Michigan), Michigan Technological University (Houghton, Michigan,) University Center Gallery (Adelphi University, New York), Suomi International College of Art and Design (Hancock, Michigan), and Janice Mason Museum (Cadiz, Kentucky). Her work has also been shown at the Janus Avivson Gallery (London England), Wetherholt Galleries (Washington, D.C.) and faculty exhibitions at Columbia University and Adelphi University.
