Meeting was called to order by President Nancy Stalls at 12:10.

Members Present: Nancy Stalls, Nada Fuqua, Jeff Ezell, Henrietta Kemp, Judy Campbell, Carolyn Self, Barbara Gardner, and Betty Liles.

Minutes: After review of the special called meeting July 28 minutes, Judy Campbell made a motion for approval which was seconded by Nada Fuqua. Motion passed.

Membership report – Betty Liles reminded everyone dues should be paid for the 2009-2010 year. Carol Lewis has sent out reminders to members who have not paid their dues.

Gallery Committee – Judy Campbell reported that the Guild has invested approximately \$2,000.00 in the hanging system and lighting at the Depot Gallery. If the Gallery is moved to the Bradford Square Mall this system could be left in the Depot. We could possibly offer the Pennyroyal Arts Council the opportunity to purchase the hanging system and lights for \$1,000.00 if they are interested. They could pay in quarterly payments if that would be helpful. Judy will speak with the director once we know we are going to move the gallery. A motion to offer this sale was made by Carolyn Self and seconded by Nada Fuqua. Motion passed.

PACI – Nancy Stalls reported the Arts Council is selling tickets for the current season.

Workshops – Betty Liles and Henrietta Kemp will be leading a workshop August 15 and 22 on creating mixed media abstract paintings. A motion was made by Carolyn Self to pay the leaders \$200.00 for conducting the workshop. It was seconded by Barbara Gardner. Motion passed.

Future workshops planned – Topic “Drawing” leader Erin Jones in October, Day - TBD.

Mall Gallery report - There has been no response from the proposal submitted to the Bradford Square Mall for us to develop a gallery.

Pennyroyal Juried Art Exhibition - The request for donations has resulted in \$1,700.00 in donations to date. There have been 3 entries for the show.

The next regular meeting will be September 10 at 12:00. Location to be determined.
