Meeting was called to order by President Nancy Stalls at 12:00.

**Minutes:** Minutes from the Nov. 12, meeting were reviewed. Motion for approval made by Carolyn Self, seconded by Betty Liles, motion carried. A Thank You note was received for the Guild's donation to the Trilogy Center for Women and the jewelry making workshop held there on Nov. 22 from 1:00 -4:00. We used Pat Howard's supplies and donations from Guild member Shirea Mills and First United Methodist Church Sunday School Classes.

**Membership report** – Betty Liles announced we currently have 83 members.

**Treasurer's report** – Treasurer Carol Lewis reported our income from Nov. 12 through Dec. 10, 2009 from the Gallery and other income was \$2,939.00 and our total expenses were \$1,462.52. The main expenses were the member reimbursements for sales, Jason Jackson's workshop, utilities and rent. We currently have a checking account balance of \$10,851.10. A motion for acceptance of the financial report was made by Betty Liles and seconded by Carolyn Self. Motion passed. Artists present were given their commission checks for the November sales.

**Mall Gallery report** – Stalls and Kemp reported on a meeting held with the mall manager to discuss mall policy manual. There were no problems with our current operating procedures. Carolyn Self and Nancy Stalls will investigate the purchase of a small used refrigerator for use in the kitchen.
