Meeting was called to order by Vice President Betty Liles at 1:00pm

Minutes: March 14, 2013 minutes were reviewed and approved as corrected.

Financial Report: Treasurer Janice Cayce presented the financial report for February. She reported we have a bank balance of \$2,337.82 as of March 29, 2013. We had expenses in March of \$2,478.74 and income of \$2,773.30. A motion to approve the report was made by Nada Fuqua and seconded by Jan Farley. Motion carried. We have a second checking account with a balance of \$141.00 for use in the payment of our of our annual Sales tax and CAM bills. Janice will deposit additional funds in this account to make it \$250.00 which is a minimum for a free account.

- Summer Art Camp for children planned – Cathy Ankeny and Amanda McNeal will lead the camps July 8 -12 and July 15-19. Motion was made by Jan Farley to donate \$25.00 toward supplies for the Camp from the Guild. Seconded by Nada Fuqua. Motion passed.
- It was agreed that we would offer to sell the Ceiling rods from our Walker Hanging system to the Christian County Chamber of Commerce. They will be exhibiting our art work in their newly renovated conference room and hallway which will possibly be ready for use beginning in May, 2013.
- St Patrick’s Weekend Art Sale – Held in Studio March 16 and 17. Guild made \$262.00 from sales and \$2,001.50 in donations from letter campaign.

New Business:

- A nominating committee will be put into place by the President for the nomination of new officers who will be voted on in June and begin office July 1, 2013. Lynn Shepherd has been working on that committee.
