Meeting Minutes: Feb. 9, 2012

President Carolyn Self presided.

Minutes of January 12, 2012, were approved as presented by Henrietta Kemp.

Financial Report was accepted as presented by Janice Cayce. Balance in checking of \$5,777.53 as of January 31, 2012. We had expenses of \$2,206.87 and income of \$476.97

Membership Chair, Betty Liles reported currently 112 members to date.

Gallery Committee Report

First artist showing in the Studio would be by Linda Pierce who will have a reception February 19th all encouraged to attend.

“Shower items” for the gallery & studio are still welcome but there is sufficient toilet tissue. Kitchen utensils & other items are needed. It was suggested that Jack/Lynn Shepherd notify membership of needs when noted.

Publicity:

It was the consensus that postcards for next quarterly exchange be given to high schools who are participating; school art programs receive money collected from their paintings at reception.

NEW BUSINESS:

- After 2 free workshops, unanimously accepted to raise fee for attendance to \$25 / member for each additional workshop.
- June 29 reception ideas approved: 1) Patriotic theme; 2) Advertise Purchases may be donated to given Vet's center, Trilogy or other PMHC facilities; (Such purchases would be tax deductible for buyer)
- Agreed to give a donation of a piece of Art to Board of Realtors in June for Military Wives event utilizing a piece remaining from auction.
- Art request for CCMS PAC Theater will be considered further after Barbara Gardner looks at Space & needs.
- Sale of ART at Fountain Square Market was presented by Holly Boggess who coordinates the Downtown farmers market. The market is open mid-April until October 31. There is no cost to have a booth on Wednesday &/ or Saturday from 7 a.m. until 1 p.m. Booths do not have to be open all of those hours. The art booth could be supervised by anyone showing/selling art there. Discussion prevailed; final decision to be made in March. It was suggested that a questionnaire be sent out to see who would be interested in this activity. Carolyn will prepare one.
- Art at Coffee Connection has been requested & Linda Pierce responded. A long hallway into Different rooms is being called the gallery. Art can be displayed for sale. They would like a variety and changes from time to time. Anyone interested may stop by the coffee shop with art pieces and methods of hanging.
