July 12, 2012

Meeting was called to order by President Carolyn Self at 1:00pm

Minutes: June 14, 2012, minutes were reviewed. Motion to approve was made by Janice Cayce, seconded by Nada Fuqua. Motion carried.

Financial Report: Treasurer Janice Cayce presented the financial report for June. She reported we have a bank balance of \$2,687.15 as of June 29, 2012. The expenses for June totaled \$1,915.13 with income of \$3,499.44. The report was approved.

Committee Reports:

- **Membership:** Betty Liles reported we currently have 65 members. A Picnic designed to recognize **new members** is being planned during September.
- **Gallery/Studio Committee:** Facility oversight committee— Jack and Lynn Shepherd asked if there were any needs with the facility. None were noted. Lynn Shepherd has developed the schedule for volunteers for the Gallery. Monthly One-Man Show in Studio – This month is Georgia Oliver. A reception will be held Saturday, July 14 from 2:00 -6:00 and members are urged to attend.

Reception July 10 from 5:00 - 8:00. Thanks again for all the great food brought and for Jim Garnett playing for us. The focus of the reception will be to encourage the public to purchase paintings to be donated and displayed at the new Veterans Shelter. There were 3 paintings purchased for donation to the center. Carolyn Self will deliver them within the next few weeks. We had a great article in the Kentucky New Era after the event which prompted a patron to call and donate another painting to the Veterans Center.

There will be no reception when the next quarterly exchange occurs at the Gallery the end of September. It was decided we would focus on a November 1st promotion for the Holiday Bazaar at the Gallery and studio. There will be two painting workshops for members to help paint ornaments to sell in the Gallery during Christmas for a Guild fundraiser. Anyone wishing to help is welcomed. Planned workdays - September 13 immediately after the Guild meeting and October 11 after the Guild meeting for 2 hours. Anyone wishing to help should contact Betty Vinson for supply information.

- **Publicity** - A newsletter was distributed to 750 people on our mailing list June 21st. It had information about the Veterans reception, upcoming classes, workshops and activities. Press releases were sent out for the reception and upcoming workshops.
