

## Hopkinsville Art Guild Minutes

June 14, 2012

Meeting was called to order by Vice President Betty Liles at 1:00pm

**Minutes:** May 10, 2012, minutes were reviewed and approved as corrected.

**Financial Report:** Treasurer Janice Cayce presented the financial report for May. She reported we have a bank balance of \$3,011.80 as of May 30, 2012. The expenses for May totaled \$2,027.80 with income of \$1,373.35. The report was approved.

### Committee Reports:

- **Membership:** Betty Liles reported we currently have 125 members. Members are reminded our dues will increase to \$40.00 for individual and \$45.00 for a family membership. Dues should be paid by July 1, 2012. Those joining after March 1, 2012 will be carried over into the 2012-2013 year as members without paying again. A new membership brochure has been developed and copied for distribution at the Gallery. A Picnic designed to recognize **new members** is being planned during September.
- **Gallery/Studio Committee:** Facility oversight committee— Jack and Lynn Shepherd asked if there were any needs with the facility. None were noted. Lynn Shepherd will begin the scheduling for the Gallery July 1<sup>st</sup>. She has been developing the schedule and will send it out to members soon.  
Monthly One-Man Show in Studio – This month is Laurel King-Davis, Meghan King and Phyllis Nelson. A reception will be held Saturday, June 16 from 5:30 -7:30 and members are urged to attend.

Next quarterly exchange will be June 24, 25. **Reception July 10 from 5:00 - 8:00.** The focus of the reception will be to encourage the public to purchase paintings to be donated and displayed at the new Veterans Shelter and Trilogy Center for Women.
