March 8, 2012

Guild Studio

Meeting was called to order by President Carolyn Self at 1:00pm

Minutes: Feb. 9, 2012, minutes were reviewed and approved as read.

Financial Report: Treasurer Janice Cayce presented the financial report for February. She reported we have a bank balance of \$4,781.27 as of February 29, 2012. The expenses for February totaled \$1,410.11 with income of \$866.71. A motion to approve the report was made by Janice Cayce and seconded by Nada Fuqua. Motion carried.

Gallery/Studio Committee:

- Facility oversight committee– No report, The membership voted to ask Jim Mason, Guy Bozard, Jack Shepherd and Bob Liles to install the new hanging system rods on the wall in the Studio next to the Gallery. They will work on Saturday, March 10 at 3:00. Linda Pierce has completed a yearly wall calendar for Studio use. Anyone wishing to utilize the Studio can check this calendar for availability and speak with Linda.
- Volunteer Coordinator – H Kemp reported the Gallery will be open 1 or 2 shifts on Wednesdays, making a total of 4 days per week the Gallery is open.
- Monthly One-Man Show in Studio - The wall in the studio can also be used for a one-person exhibit if desired for a one month period starting in March. Those using this area may wish to have personal reception for their exhibit for no charge. Anyone wishing to have a one-person display in the studio should contact Betty Liles, gallery coordinator. There is only one month open at the current time.
