May 10, 2012

Meeting was called to order by President Carolyn Self at 1:00pm

Members Present: Janice Cayce, Nancy Stalls, Linda Pierce, Betty Liles, Betty Vinson, Leoma Howery, Carolyn Self, and Henrietta Kemp.

Minutes: April 12, 2012, minutes were reviewed and approved as corrected.

Financial Report: Treasurer Janice Cayce presented the financial report for April. She reported we have a bank balance of \$4,067.35 as of March 30, 2012. The expenses for April totaled \$1,445.52 with income of \$910.09. A motion to approve the report was made by Nancy Stalls and seconded by Leoma Howery. Motion carried.

Committee Reports:

- **Membership:** Betty Liles reported we currently have 124 members. Members are reminded our dues will increase to \$40.00 for individual and \$45.00 for family memberships. Dues should be paid by July 1, 2012. Those joining after March 1, 2012 will be carried over into the 2012-2013 year as members without paying again. A new membership brochure has been developed and copied for distribution at the Gallery.
