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### Minutes

September 13 2012

Meeting was called to order by Vice President Betty Liles at 1:10pm

**Minutes:** August 9, 2012 minutes were reviewed and approved as presented.

**Financial Report:** Treasurer Janice Cayce presented the financial report for August, 2012. She reported we have a bank balance of \$4,547.72 as of August 29,2012. A motion to approve the report was made by Guy Bozard and seconded by Tanya Ezell. Motion carried.

**Membership:** Betty Liles reported we currently have 82 members.

### Gallery/Studio Committee:

Next Quarterly Gallery art change will be Sept. 30<sup>th</sup> and October 1<sup>st</sup>. Those exhibiting are reminded to come and change their hanging art work.

**Facility oversight committee**– Lynn Shepherd asked about scheduling workers in the Gallery for December. Anyone willing to work an extra shift in December would be appreciated. She is working to have the Gallery open Wednesday through Sunday the first three weeks of December. There will be 20 tables during the Christmas Bazaar which will begin November 23. We will once again reduce the commission on pieces sold from 25% to 10% on all items sold starting November 23 through December 23.

There will be two work sessions at the Studio to paint ornaments to sell in the Gallery for Guild fundraiser. They will be after the next 2 Guild meetings, September 13 and October 11. Betty Vinson had supplies ready for those staying after the meeting to work.

**Publicity:** No postcards or reception will be held for this quarterly art change due to the reception at HCC for the PJAE and the start of the Christmas Bazaar will occur the end of November.

**New Business:**

**Spring Silent Art Auction** at Hopkinsville Country Club, Feb. 14, 2013. President Carolyn Self and Susan Rochelle met with management representatives from the Hopkinsville Country Club and they have agreed to offer this opportunity to us at no cost. They will have approximately 150 in attendance for their Valentines Banquet that evening. Guild members are welcomed to attend as well for a cost of \$50.00 per couple. In order to raise money for Guild expenses members will be asked to donate at least one piece of art to be placed in a silent auctioned that evening or at other times during the year at the Gallery. It will be hoped several of these are large pieces which are well framed. Small paintings, photos, jewelry, and wood turnings are also welcomed. All donations need to be delivered to the Guild Studio by January 15 in order to create a catalog of all items for sale for the guests use for bidding. Jim Mason agreed to make 4 easels to be used that evening for the cost of materials at approximately \$40.00 each.

Tanya Ezell suggested we place a large sign in front of Bradford Square Mall advertising our Christmas Bazaar. It was discussed that it be 3' by 4' in size. No one was assigned to investigate the cost, approval by Mall management or requirements for putting up the sign. Tanya also presented a sample of a questionnaire which could be given to visitors to the Gallery to complete for a possible door prize.
