A suggestion was made we purchase name tags to wear at events and while working in the gallery. No decision was made.

A motion was made by Linda Pierce and seconded by Gabriele Wardeiner to reduce the gallery commission charged to artists exhibiting at the gallery to 10% during the Christmas Bazaar. Motion passed. There are several small pieces being sold and it was felt this would be appropriate at this time.
