L&N Depot Gallery Committee – Judy Campbell reported will offer the Pennyroyal Arts Council the opportunity to purchase the hanging system and lights for \$1,000.00 if they are interested. They could pay in quarterly payments if that would be helpful. Judy will speak with the director. There are artist scheduled to exhibit in November and another interested in January. The decision about continuing to have visiting artist exhibits will be discussed further as policies are developed for the new Guild Gallery

PACI report – Nancy Stalls reported the Guild will have a display at the Alhambra on Sept. 17 for the tour of Military Wives during Salute Ft. Campbell Week.

Mall Gallery report – The Gallery liability insurance through Higgins Insurance will be secured and the lease will be notarized, signed and returned to Randa Kisselbaugh. The utility hookup will be completed within the next 2 weeks. The Gallery will plan to open the middle of October with a Grand opening possibly on October 23rd from 5:00 - 8:00. (**possibly changed to Ribbon Cutting at 10:00 on Oct. 29**) The Gallery policies were reviewed. Carolyn Self will work on a revised draft to be adopted at the next meeting. The requirement of a land line phone may make the use of a Credit Card machine cost prohibitive.

Pennyroyal Juried Art Exhibition - The request for donations has resulted in \$2,300.00 in donations to date. There have been 40 entries for the show.
